Signs - John 2:18; **σημείον** (saymayon): a sign, mark, token, a sign of miracles and wonders, signs of divine authority. Matthew 12:38, 39; 16:1,4; Mark 8:11,12; Luke 11:16,29; 23:8; John 2:11,18,23; 4:54; 6:30; 10:41; 12:18; Acts 4:16,22. In the plural, 'signs', Mark 16:17,20; John 2:11,23; 3:2; 6:2,14,26; 7:31; 9:16; 11:47; 12:37; 20:30; Acts 8:6; I Corinthians 1:22.

Show - John 2:18; **δείκνυμι** (dayknumee): to show, exhibit. Matthew 4:8; 8:4; Mark 1:44; 14:15; Luke 4:5; 5:14; 20:24; 22:12; 24:40; John 2:18; 5:20; 10:32; 20:20; Acts 7:3; I Timothy 6:15; Hebrews 8:5; Revelation 17:1; 21:9, 10; 22:1,8.

Temple - John 2:19; **ναός** (naos): 20, 21: a temple; the whole temple enclosure, Matthew 23:16, 17, 21; 27:5, 40; John 2:20; the inner sanctuary, Matthew 23:35; 27:51; Mark 15:38; Luke 1:9, 21, 22; 23:45; II Thessalonians 2:4(?); . Parallel or referencing to this usage, where Jesus refers to His body, Matthew 26:61; 27:40; Mark 14:58; 15:29; John 2:19; 21; The body of a person who is in Christ, I Corinthians 3:16, 17; 6:19; II Corinthians 6:16; Ephesians 2:21. Other uses, Acts 17:24; 19:24. **Ναός** (naos) in Revelation: 3:12; 7:15; 11:1; 11:19; 14:15; 14:17; 15:5; 16:1; 16:17; 21:22.*

Body - John 2:21; **σῶμα** (soma): (see GNTSH June 11, 2006): The physical body of Christ, while He was on earth, Matthew 26:12, 'for in pouring this fragrant oil on my body, she did it for my burial' (Mark 14:8); 27:58, 'He went to Pilate and asked for the body of Jesus. Then Pilate commanded the body to be given to him' (Mark 15:43; Luke 23:52; John 19:38); Luke 23:55; 24:3, 23; John 2:21; 19:40; 20:12. The spiritual body of Christ, Romans 12:5; I Corinthians 10:16, 17; 12:13, 27; Ephesians 1:23; 2:16; 4:4, 12, 16; 5:23, 30; Colossians 1:18, 24; 2:19; 3:15.

Raised from the dead – John 2:22; **ἐγείρω ἐκ νεκρῶν** (egayro ek nekron): This phrase (or a close approximation): Matthew 17:9; Mark 6:14, 16; Luke 9:7; John 2:22; 12:1,9, 17; 21:14; Acts 3:15; 4:10; 13:30; Romans 6:4, 9; 7:4; 8:11; 10:9; I Corinthians 15:12, 20; Galatians 1:1; Ephesians 1:20; Colossians 2:12; I Thessalonians 1:10; II Timothy 2:8; Hebrews 11:19; I Peter 1:21.
