**Marveled** - John 4:27; **θαυμάζω** (thaumadzo): to marvel, wonder, wonder at. Matthew 8:10, 27; 9:33; 15:31; 21:20; 22:22; 27:14; Mark 5:20; 15:5; Luke 1:21; 8:25; 11:14; 24:41(40), 'And when He had said this, He showed them His hands and His feet. But while they still did not believe for joy, and marveled, He said to them, Have you any food here?'; John 5:20; 7:15; Act 2:7; 4:13; 13:41.

**Come** - John 4:29; **δεῦτε** (deute): An adverb. Come on! Come here! Come! Matthew 4:19; 11:28; 21:38; 22:4; 25:34; 28:6; Mark 1:17; 6:31; 12:7; John 4:29; 21:12; Revelation 19:17.\*

**Food** - John 4:32; **βρώσις** (brosis) [34 **βρώμα** (broma)]: In John **βρώσις** (brosis) is equivalent to **βρώμα** (broma) as is evidenced by this passage (see :32, 34 below: the first word for 'food' is brosis, the second is broma). Food. **βρώσις** Brosis – John 4:32; 6:27, 55; Romans 14:17; I Corinthians 8:4; II Corinthians 9:10; Colossians 2:16; Hebrews 12:16. Matthew 6:19, 20 (rust, corrosion). **βρώμα** Broma – Matthew 14:15; Mark 7:19; Luke 3:11; 9:13; John 4:34; Romans 14:15, 20; I Corinthians 3:2; 6:13; 8:8; 10:3; I Timothy 4:3; Hebrews 9:10; 13:9.\*

**Finish** - John 4:34; **τελειόω** (teleioo): to bring to an end, finish, accomplish, complete, perfect, fulfil. Luke 2:43; 3:32; John 4:34; 5:36; 17:4, 23; 19:28; Acts 20:24; Philippians 3:12; Hebrews 2:10; 5:9; 7:19,28; 9:9; 10:1, 14; 11:40; 12:23; James 2:22; I John 2:5; 4:12, 17, 18;

**Look at** - John 4:35; **θεάομαι** (theaomai): to behold, look upon, contemplate, view (sometimes with a sense of wondering); in the Greek New Testament, always literal, physically careful and deliberate vision which understands the object being viewed. Matthew 6:1; 11:7; 16:14; 22:11; 23:5; Mark 16:11; Luke 5:27; 7:24; 23:55; John 1:14, 32, 38; 4:35; 6:5; 11:45; Acts 1:11; 21:27; 22:9; Romans 15:24; I John 1:1; 4:12, 14.\*
