John 8:48-59

Samaritan - John 8:48; **σαμαρείτης** (samareitays): Samaritan. Jesus was still in the temple (:20) in the treasury. Samaritans would not be allowed here. See Matthew 10:5; Luke 9:52; 10:33; 16:6; John 4:9, 39, 40, Acts 8:25. He had called into question their lineage in 8:37-47. They were now calling His lineage into question. They knew He had been in Samaria, Luke 17:11-19; John 4:4-43.

Honor - John 8:49; **τιμάω** (timaō): to value, set a price for. Matthew 27:9. To honor. Quotes from the Old Testament: Matthew 15:4, 6, 8; 19:19; Luke 18:20; Ephesians 6:2. Also Mark 7:6, 10; 10:19; John 5:23; 8:49; 12:26; I Timothy 5:3; I PT 2:17. Acts 28:10.*

Dishonor - John 8:49; **ἀτιμάζω** (atimadzo): to dishonor, insult. Take away **τιμή** (timay) (value, honor). Thus to devalue, to consider of no value. Mark 12:4; Luke 20:11; John 8:49; Acts 5:41; Romans 1:24; 2:23; James 2:6 (5-6).

Keep - John 8:51; **τηρεω** (tayreo) – watch over, guard, keep, preserve, give heed to, observe, pay attention to. John 8:51, 52, 55; 14:23, 24; 15:20; 17:6.

Shall never see death - John 8:51; **θάνατον οὐ μὴ θεωρήσῃ** (thanaton ou may theoraysay): only here in the Greek New Testament, but see **ἰδεῖν** (idein, 'see') Luke 2:26; Hebrews 11:5. Compare Psalms 89:48 (LXX 88:49) 'Is there a man who shall live and not see death?'. In general, seeing physical things John 12:45; 9:8. Seeing signs and wonders, John 2:23, 6:2, 19, 40, 62; 7:3.

Taste death – John 8:52; **γεύσονται** – taste. With death, Matthew 16:26; Mark 9:1; Luke 9:27; Hebrews 2:9. Used in the Talmud, but not in the Old Testament (LXX).

I AM - John 8:58; **ἐγὼ εἰμι** (ego eimi): The reference to the God of Exodus chapter 3; 'tell them that I AM has sent you'. See GNTSH of August 10, 2008. Jesus 'if you do not believe that I AM, you will die in your sins'. Also verse 28, 'and you will know that I AM'. See also John 4:26; 6:20, 35, 41, 48, 51; 8:12, 18, 24, 28, 58, 'Before Abraham was I AM'.

* All References in the Greek New Testament

Jesus said to them, Truly truly I say to you, before Abraham was, I AM. Then they took up stones that they might throw them on Him, but Jesus was hidden and went out of the temple after He went through the midst of them and so went by. **Gospel According to John 8:58-59**

εἶπεν αὐτοῖς ὁ Ἰησοῦς Ἀμὴν ἀμὴν λέγω ὑμῖν πρὶν Ἀβραάμ γενέσθαι ἐγὼ εἰμί ἦσαν οὖν λίθους ἵνα βάλωσιν ἐπ' αὐτόν Ἰησοῦς δὲ ἐκρύβη καὶ ἐξῆλθεν ἐκ τοῦ ἱεροῦ διελθὼν διὰ μέσου αὐτῶν καὶ παροῆγεν οὕτως .
